Hydric Soils

The following soils have been classified by the U.S. Natural Resources Conservation Service to be indicators of the presence of wetlands. This list is only a guide. An area which is covered by one of these soil types is very likely to be a wetland, according to the definition of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, although not definitely.
