

ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 04

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING PERMIT AND LICENSING FEES
WITHIN THE CITY OF BYRON

WHEREAS, the City of Byron has the authority to regulate matters affecting the health, safety and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the cost of inspection and administrative costs have continued to increase; and

WHEREAS, the permit/inspection and licensing fees charged by the City do not currently cover the costs of performing the inspections and/or administrative expenses incurred by the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BYRON, OGLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 5.12.020B be and is hereby repealed eliminating the license fee for an Amusement.

SECTION TWO: Section 5.20.010 by and is hereby repealed eliminating the licensing fee for a Billiard/Pool Hall.

SECTION THREE: Section 5.40.040 regarding fees for a permit relating to a door-to-door solicitor shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

5.40.040 Permit Issuance. The fee for a license under this Chapter shall be \$25.00. The City Clerk shall issue a license permitting commercial home merchandising or solicitation after an applicant has completed the application for a permit as required in Section 5.40.030 and paid the applicable fee.

SECTION FOUR: Section 5.36.040A Regarding a license fee for Pedlars shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

5.36.040 License/Fees. The fees for licenses shall be as follows:

- A. For pedlars using a cart, wagon, automobile or other vehicle, \$50.00 for an annual license.

SECTION FIVE: Section 5.52.020D Regarding a License Fee for a Raffle be and is hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX: Section 8.22.040 shall be amended to increase the annual permit fee from \$15.00 to \$100.00.

SECTION SEVEN: Section 8.22.050 shall be amended by adding Subparagraph D to read in its entirety as follows:

- D. All materials and contents must be contained wholly within the collection/donation container.

SECTION EIGHT: Section 15.01.040 Building Permit Fees shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

15.01.040 Building Permit Fees. The fees for building permits shall be as follows:

- A. Residential New Construction: \$750.00, plus mechanical inspection fees as required by the Building & Zoning Administrator.
- B. Business/Commercial New Construction: \$1,000.00, plus mechanical inspection fees as required by the Building & Zoning Administrator.
- C. Patio, Decks and Porches (without a roof): \$75.00
- D. Outbuildings, unattached garages and porches (with a roof): \$ 0.22 per square foot for structures over 100 square feet (a minimum of \$50.00), plus mechanical inspection fees as required by the Building & Zoning Administrator.
- E. Remodeling: \$75.00, plus mechanical inspection fees as required by the Building & Zoning Administrator.
- F. Additions to existing structures not otherwise covered under Subsections A through E: \$250.00.

SECTION NINE: Section 15.10.030 Regarding the Fee for a Demolition Permit shall increase from \$50.00 to \$75.00.

SECTION TEN: Section 15.01.045 Regarding Mechanical Inspection Fees shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

15.01.045 Inspection Fees. The fees for inspections shall be as follows:

- A. Electrical inspection: \$75.00 per inspection.
- B. Plumbing inspection: \$75.00 per inspection.
- C. Re-Inspection: \$75.00 per inspection.
- D. Electrical service upgrade: \$75.00 per inspection.

SECTION ELEVEN: Section 8.58.060 Regarding Fees for Permits for a Swimming Pool and/or Hot Tub/Spa shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

8.58.060 Permit Fees.

- A. The fee for a permit to construct a private swimming pool (above ground) shall be \$75.00 (includes electrical inspection)
- B. The fee for a permit to construct a private swimming pool (in ground) shall be \$150.00 (includes electrical inspection).
- C. The fee for a permit to construct a hot tub/spa, whether constructed indoors or outdoors, shall be \$50.00 (includes electrical inspection).

SECTION TWELVE: Section 15.42.030 Regarding Fence Permit Fees shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

15.42.030 Permit-Fee. The fee for a fence permit shall be \$60.00. This fee shall apply whether the fence permit is for the construction of a new fence or for the alteration of an existing fence. Such fees shall be paid at the time the Fence Permit Application is submitted.

SECTION THIRTEEN: Section 12.20.160A Regarding Sign Permits shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

12.20.160 Permit Fee. A. The permit fee for the erection or construction of signs shall be \$50.00. However, if the erection or construction of the sign involves the change of a panel only, the fee shall be \$25.00.

SECTION FOURTEEN: Section 17.48.180A Regarding Zoning Fees shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

17.48.180 Fees.

- A. Minimum Fees. The following minimum fees shall be paid at the time an Application for Zoning Map Amendment, Variance or Special Use is submitted:
 - 1. Zoning Map Amendment - \$400.00.
 - 2. Request for Variance - \$250.00.
 - 3. Special Use Permit - \$300.00.

SECTION FIFTEEN: Any Ordinances or Resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.


SECTION SIXTEEN: This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as required by law.
