The Planning Commission may permit other plant materials if the types are hardy to the area, are not subject to blight or disease, and are the same general character and growth habit as those listed below. Use of plant materials that are native to New Hanover and the general area is encouraged, as stated in the current New Hanover Township Comprehensive Plan. All plant material shall conform to the standards set forth in ANSI Z60.1 (American Standard for Nursery Stock) as revised. Invasive plant materials as currently defined by the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources shall be prohibited. Other plant materials not listed in this Section will be permitted at the discretion of the Township.

 - (3) *Acer saccharum*—Sugar Maple (native).
 - (4) *Fagus grandifolia*—American Beech (native).
 - (5) *Fagus sylvatica*—European Beech.
 - (6) *Fraxinus americana*—White Ash (native).
 - (7) *Fraxinus Pennsylvania lanceolata* (cv. Marshall's Seedless)—Green Ash (native)
 - (8) *Ginkgo biloba*—Ginkgo (male only).
 - (9) *Gleditsia triacanthos inermis*—Thornless Honey Locust.
 - (10) *Liquidambar styraciflua*—Sweet Gum (native).
 - (11) *Liriodenendron tilipifera*—Tulip Tree (native).
 - (12) *Platanus acerifolia*—London Plane Tree.
 - (13) *Quercus alba*—White Oak (native).
 - (14) *Quercus borealis*—Red Oak (native).
 - (15) *Quercus coccinea*—Scarlet Oak (native).
 - (16) *Quercus phellos*—Willow Oak (native).
 - (17) *Sophora japonica*—Japanese Pagodatree.
 - (18) *Tilia*-Linden—all species hardy to the area.
 - (19) *Zelkova serrata*—Japanese Zelkova.

 - (5) *Crataegus phaenopyrum*—Washington Hawthorn.
