

Amendment to Ordinance 13-1-143(b) and 13-1-143(e)(1)
Swimming pools and hot tubs

The Common Council of the City of Greenwood do ordain and establish as follows:

- 1) **Section 13-1-143(b) and 13-1-143(e)(1)** of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Greenwood shall be amended as follows:

(b) Exempt Pools. Storable children's swimming or wading pools, with a maximum wall height of 24 inches and which are so constructed that it may be readily disassembled for storage and reassembled to its original integrity are exempt from the provisions of this Section. However, swimming pools or wading pools with a wall height greater than 24 inches and which are so constructed that it may be readily disassembled for storage and reassembled to its original integrity shall be subject to the enclosure requirements set forth in 13-1-143(e)(1).

(e) Enclosures.

(1) Except as hereinafter provided, every outdoor swimming pool and hot tub shall be completely surrounded by a fence or wall in addition to the pool wall of an above ground pool. Said fence or wall shall be constructed to a height of no less than 4 feet. Any fence or wall shall be located to a minimum horizontal distance of four feet from the edge of the swimming pool or hot tub. Every storable swimming or wading pool with a wall height of greater than 24 inches and which are so constructed that it may be readily disassembled for storage and reassembled, shall be completely surrounded by a fence which may be a temporary fence in addition to the pool wall. The temporary fence shall be at least 48 inches high. Said temporary fence shall be constructed of wood or plastic materials similar to the materials used for temporary snow fences and shall be staked in such a manner to remain in an upright position at all times. Said temporary fence, however, shall not be the orange color of a typical snow fence but shall be a more neutral color such as green or brown or black color. The fence shall be constructed so that it is secure in surrounding the entire pool and shall be equipped with a latching device capable of keeping the fence securely closed at all times when not in actual use. Said temporary fence and stakes shall be maintained during the time that said fence is on the premises so as to provide a safety barrier around said pool. The fence and stakes shall not be erected on the premises before May 1st of each year and shall be removed by October 1st of each year.

- 2) **Penalty.** A violation of this Ordinance shall result in the imposition of a penalty as set forth in the general penalty section of the Code of Ordinances located in Section 1-1-7.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.

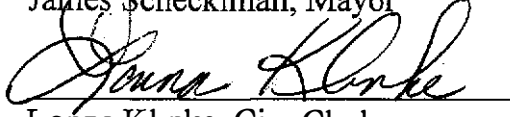
