Table 3.1 Sign Type Definitions**

Sign Type	Illustration	Definition
Awning sign		A sign consisting of a written message or logo located on the exterior of fabric or ridged material that is attached to a building.
Electronic message sign		A sign with a changing text message that is displayed using lights manipulated through digital input, “digital ink” or any other method or technology.
Wall sign		A single-faced sign attached to or erected against an exterior wall of a building with the face in a parallel plane to the plane of the building wall.
Window sign		A sign placed inside a building in a display window to convey information to people located to the outside of building, either through lighting, lettering or placard.

SHERWOOD CODE

Sign Type	Illustration	Definition
Monument sign		A sign which is architecturally designed, set directly at grade, and the base width dimension is equal to or greater than the overall height of the sign.
Multitenant sign		A group of commercial retail establishments with a designed occupancy of four or more tenants with shared parking and visual appearance as a contiguous structure which may or may not be planned, constructed or managed as a total entity.
Off-premises sign		Any sign that is located outdoors and that advertises a product, business, service, event, or any other matter that is not available, or does not take place, on the same premises as the sign.
Pole or pylon sign		A sign supported by a post or posts so that the sign and supports are finished to grade.

Sign Type	Illustration	Definition
Sandwich board sign		A double-sided, freestanding ground sign consisting of ridged material, open at the bottom and hinged at the top.
Temporary sign		A sign which is designed or intended to be displayed for a short period of time and is not permanently installed. This includes items such as banners, flags of other than a political jurisdiction, sandwich or curb signs.
Projecting sign		A sign attached to the wall of a building that projects outward (typically at a perpendicular angle) from the building face.
