Appendix I Performance Standards

All uses shall comply with the following:

- A. The volume of sound, the emission or discharge of odorous gases or toxic or noxious matter, or dust, fumes, gas, mist, smoke, vapor, pollen or any combination thereof shall comply with Article 19, Title 7, of the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York, otherwise known as the "Air Pollution Control Act" or with any code, rule or regulation which shall be promulgated pursuant to the Air Pollution Control Act, or any subsequent revision or amendment.
- B. Vibration. An operation which creates intense earth-shaking vibration, e.g., heavy drop forges, heavy hydraulic surges, shall not be discernible recurrently beyond the property lines of the industry.
- C. Radioactivity. No operations shall be permitted which cause radioactivity in violation of Title 10, Chapter 1, Part 20, Code of Federal Regulations, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," dated June 16, 1957, or any subsequent revision or amendment.
- D. Glare. No direct or reflected glare shall be detectable from any Residential District boundaries.
- E. Heat. No direct or reflected heat shall be detectable from any Residential District or Commercial District boundaries.
