NOTES:

(a) Preexisting, nonconforming residential lots with or without residences:

For single-family dwellings:

If the lot width is less than 70 feet but greater than 66 feet, then the minimum side yard setbacks shall be modified proportionately using the ratio of the actual lot width to the required minimum lot width without the need for an area variance, provided that one side yard shall not have a width of less than six feet and the other side yard a width of not less than 12 feet.

If the lot width is less than 66 feet, then the minimum side yard setbacks shall be modified proportionately using the ratio of the actual lot width to the required minimum lot width without the need for an area variance provided that one side yard shall not have a width of less than four feet and the other side yard a width of not less than eight feet.

(b) Corner lots shall have side yard along the street side of not less than 12 feet.

(c) Accessory structures located in a side yard shall comply with the setback requirements of the principal building.
