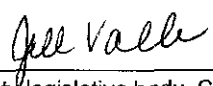

§ 600-7.3 Architectural and site plan approval required.

A.

No building permit shall be issued without site plan and architectural review approval for:

(1) New commercial and residential buildings or structures, new commercial parking lots, new or replacement of cellular or communication antennas, equipment or devices.

(2) New exterior signage or awnings for commercial use buildings/tenants.

(3) Alterations to commercial and residential buildings or structures of more than 25% of the area to the front or any facade of a building facing a public way or street except alterations to a building or structure in the rear yard or other location that is not conspicuous from a public street or a public way.

(4) Any new or altered land use activities.

(5) Additions to commercial and residential buildings or structures except as noted below.

a) Residential front terraces, porches or porticos. Wood decks.

b) Residential detached accessory structures in the rear and side yards such as detached garages, cabanas, pergolas, sheds, swimming pools, and other accessory structures or buildings.

c) Residential additions except additions to a building or structure in the rear yard or other location that is not conspicuous from a public street or a public way.

d) Commercial detached accessory structures 100 sq. ft. or less in the rear yard or other location that is not conspicuous from a public street or a public way.

(6) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the Superintendent of Buildings and/or the Board of Trustees to require approvals per this section for proposed work not specifically listed in this chapter.
