AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER
258, "UTILITIES," ARTICLE II, "PUBLIC
RIGHT-OF-WAY," SECTION 258-20, TO
ALLOW THE TOWNSHIP SAFETY
OFFICER TO ENFORCE THE
PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE II

GROSSE ILE TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE.

Chapter 258, "Utilities," Article II, "Public Right-of-Way," Section 258-20, "Stop-work order; review procedure," is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 258-20 Stop-work order; review procedure.

The Director of Public Works *or their designee, or the Township Safety Officer,* may issue a stop-work order to anyone violating this article, the Township Code, or state or federal law. All operations for which a permit is granted pursuant to the terms of this article are under the supervision of the Director of Public Works *or the Township Board appointed Safety Officer or their designees.* If a permit is refused, suspended or revoked, the applicant may within 10 days of the denial, suspension or revocation appeal that determination to the Township Board of Trustees. The Township Board of Trustees may, after proper notice to all interested parties, conduct a hearing concerning the refusal, suspension or revocation. After conducting the public hearing the Township Board of Trustees may either affirm, modify or reverse the decision of the Director of Public Works *or their designee, or the Township Safety Officer.* The decision of the Township Board of Trustees is final.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS

All resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance or a summary of this Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township of Grosse Ile within fifteen (15) days after its adoption.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication, as provided by law.
