

ORDINANCE No. 1060

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, SECTION 1701 OF THE ROY CITY ZONING ORDINANCE BY ESTABLISHING A CATEGORY AND ASSOCIATED REGULATIONS FOR TATTOO AND BODY ART WITHIN TABLE 17-2.

WHEREAS, the Roy City Council finds that it is advisable and beneficial to update the table of uses to include a new category for Tattoo and Body Art; and

WHEREAS, the Roy City Council finds that additional regulations for the operation of Tattoo and Body Art businesses will be of benefit and use in maintaining and increasing the long-term viability of commercial areas which are important to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Roy City Planning Commission held public hearings as required by law and has favorably recommended the amendment to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Roy City Council has received and reviewed the recommendation of the Planning Commission and City Staff, finding it to be consistent with the goals and policies of the Roy City Zoning Ordinance and General Plan, and has reviewed and considered the same in a public meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it hereby ordained by the City Council of Roy City, Utah, that Chapter 17, Section 1701, Table 17-2 be amended by adding the category of Tattoo and Body Art to read as follows:

To be indicated as "Conditional Use" in the Regional Commercial Zone, and "Prohibited" in all other Zones.

Tattoo & Body Art. *Establishments engaged primarily in the practice of physical body adornment or modification, including but not limited to body piercing, tattooing, branding or scarification. All Tattoo & Body Art establishments shall obtain and maintain in good standing a proper license from the Weber-Morgan Health Department. Tattoo & Body Art establishments may not be located closer than six hundred (600) feet to any other such establishment as defined, or to any church, school or other community gathering place. The number of such facilities licensed within the city limits may not exceed one per every ten thousand (10,000) or portion thereof of the most recent United States Census Bureau estimated population of Roy City. The hours of operation are limited to between 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. No minors shall be allowed on the premises without an accompanying adult guardian.*




