

ORDINANCE 1078

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECREATING SECTION
4-5-1 – BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT – CREATION
PROVIDING THAT THE LANDER PLANNING COMMISSION
SHALL ACT AS THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT
AND AMENDING SECTION 4-7-1(a) – CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Lander, Fremont County, Wyoming: that City Code section 4-5-1 – Board of Adjustment – Creation – is hereby repealed and recreating a new section 4-5-1 as follows:

4-5-1 – Board of Adjustment – A Board of Adjustment consisting of the Lander Planning Commission is hereby created in accordance with W.S. 15-1-605. The Board of Adjustment shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to the conduct of its function which are consistent with the ordinance and state law. A copy of such rules shall be kept on file by the City Clerk for public inspection.

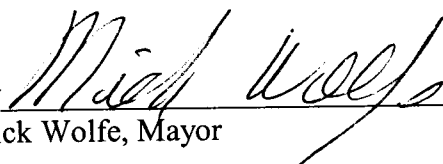
4-7-1(a) – City Planning Commission – Creation –

- (a) A Planning Commission for the City of Lander of **seven** members is established in accordance with Wyoming Statutes Section 15-1-502 (1977) as the same now exists or may hereafter be amended. Members shall be representative of different occupations and appointed without respect to political affiliation by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Council. The term of each member shall be four years.

Whereas an emergency exists, and such is declared to be the facts, this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and approval.

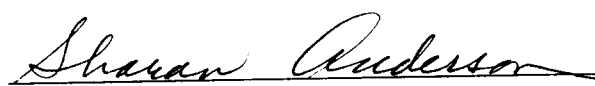
