

ORDINANCE 1022

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING SECTION 4-11-10 (a)(i) &
AMENDING SECTION 4-11-10(a)(iii) OF
THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LANDER
PERTAINING TO OFF STREET PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LANDER,
FREMONT COUNTY, WYOMING:

SECTION 1: Section 4-11-10 (a)(i) is hereby suspending businesses with Main Street frontage located between First Street and Ninth Street which shall not be required to provide off-street parking. This suspension shall by its own terms and be of no further force and effect after 12:00 midnight 6 months from the passage hereof. Provided however, that prior to said expiration date, the governing body may, by resolution, extend the termination date hereof for an additional 6 months.

SECTION 2: Section 4-11-10(a)(iii) is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (iii) in residential districts, required off-street parking shall be provided on the same lot to which the parking pertains. In other districts, such parking may be provided either on the same lot or on another lot not in a residential district, located not farther than **1000** feet from the building or use they are required to serve;

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Lander.
