

ORDINANCE 1039

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTIONS 4-11-10(a) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
FOR THE CITY OF LANDER PERTAINING
TO OFF STREET PARKING IN CERTAIN
AREAS OF THE C-1 ZONE

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Lander, Fremont County, Wyoming:

SECTION 1: Section 4-11-10(a) (vi) of the Lander City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (vi) The requirements of 4-11-10, with the exception of 4-11-10(a)(v), shall not be applicable with regards to structures with main street frontage that are located between First Street and Ninth Street, and no additional off street parking, beyond what is provided on the date of the enactment of this Ordinance, shall be required with regards to such structures.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law and the ordinances of the City of Lander.
