

ORDINANCE NO. 1535

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, ZONING, CHAPTER 30 SIGNS RELATED TO NEW PROVISIONS CREATED TO REGULATE TEMPORARY DECAL INSTALLATIONS

The City Council of the City of Burnsville, Minnesota ordains as follows:

Section 1. Title 10, Chapter 30: SIGNS, Section 2: DEFINITIONS of the Burnsville City

Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

TEMPORARY DECAL INSTALLATION: A sign installation upon an exterior wall or façade of a structure which is designed to be displayed for a limited duration subject to the standards outlined in 10-30-10 and could be used to identify commercial or non-commercial speech. Also known as building wrap.

Section 2. Title 10, Chapter 30: SIGNS, Section 10: Reserved is hereby amended by adding

the underlined language to create a section as follows:

10-30-10: TEMPORARY DECAL INSTALLATION~~RESERVED~~:

Temporary Decal Installations shall be allowed by permit in B-1, B-2, B-3, B-4, CRD, I-1, I-2, I-3, GIM, GIH Districts, commercial uses in a MIX or TOD District and conditional uses in R Districts.

- (A) Wall Type and Composition: Temporary Decal Installations shall be allowed on permitted Major Exterior Materials as referenced in 10-19-1-(A)3 and 10-23-1-(A)3 as applicable.
1. Proof of manufacturer's specifications shall be supplied prior to issuance of a sign permit.
- (B) Temporary Decal Installation Standards: These signs if placed in accordance with the following standards, will not apply toward the maximum allowable sign area, but shall comply with all other applicable provisions of this title:
1. A permit is required and shall be valid for three (3) years. A maximum of one permit is allowed per street frontage per property. In the case of multiple buildings on one lot, the frontage standard shall apply to each separate structure.
 2. Temporary Decal Installations shall not be used in place of permanent signage.
 3. When a Temporary Decal Installation is used to wrap the façade of a structure, the window signage allowance referenced in 10-30-4-(A)5 shall not apply.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective February 1st, 2021 upon its passage and publication according to law.
