

ORDINANCE 2013-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SELECT PROVISIONS OF THE SOUTH JORDAN CITY MUNICIPAL CODE DEALING WITH CITY APPOINTED BOARDS, COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS, AND TASK FORCES

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of South Jordan to clarify by City ordinance the manner in which City Council creates boards, commissions, committees, and task forces.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SOUTH JORDAN CITY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. **Amendment.** Section 2.76.010 of the South Jordan City Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Chapter 2.76

BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES, AND TASK FORCES

2.76.010: GENERAL RULES

- A. Creation: The City Council may create boards, commissions, committees, and task forces (“Boards/Commissions”) as provided by law.
- B. Applicability: Unless otherwise provided by state law, ~~or~~ federal law of this code, this Chapter shall apply to all city boards, commissions, committees, and task forces (“Boards/Committees”) whether presently organized or to be organized at a future date.
- C. Procedural Guide: City Council created Boards/Committees shall be governed by the “Policy & Procedural Guide for City Boards/Committees” (“Procedural Guide”) which may be amended from time to time by resolution of the city council.

SECTION 2. **Amendment.** Chapter 17.08 of the South Jordan Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

Chapter 17.08 DEFINITIONS GENERALLY

17.08.010: DEFINITIONS: The purpose of this chapter is to provide specific meanings for terms as they are used in this title and to facilitate the understanding and administration of the provisions of this title. Meanings shall apply to the singular or

plural and to any tense of a verb. Definitions of pertinent terms provided in Utah Code Annotated are adopted as part of this title.

BOARD OF

ADJUSTMENT: An individual or a group of individuals appointed by the city council to hear appeals and applications for variances to city land use requirements as provided under state law and City ordinance.

PLANNING

COMMISSION: A group of South Jordan City residents appointed by the city council to meet regularly to review general plan issues, current planning and land use issues, proposed development projects and other matters as directed by the city council as provided under state law and City ordinance.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance and all sections, parts, provisions and words of this Ordinance shall be severable.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication or posting as required by law.


