ORDINANCE NO. 80-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE NO. 1157.18 "PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIALLY ZONED DISTRICTS" TO ADD ALL VEHICLES TO THE PROHIBITION; AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Niles has previously adopted an ordinance regulation the off-street parking of motor vehicles for the health, safety and improvement of the community; and

WHEREAS, continued efforts to maintain residential properties requires the amendment of the ordinance to add additional vehicles to the prohibition on off-street parking for the further enhancement and protection of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Codified Ordinance No. 1157.18 PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIALLY ZONED DISTRICTS is hereby amended to read:

"a. In any residentially zoned district, no person shall stand or park, or permit to stand or be parked, a motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, truck, vehicle and/or construction equipment on the tree lawn, or on the front, rear or side yards or lawn."

SECTION 2: In all other respects, Codified Ordinance No. 1157.18 shall remain the same.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the public health, welfare and safety for the reason that the immediate enforcement of this measure is necessary for the health, welfare, safety and protection of the community. As such an emergency measure this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor. If not so passed as an emergency, it shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

WHEREAS, the City of Niles has previously adopted an ordinance regulating the off-street parking of motor vehicles for the health, safety and improvement of the community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NILES, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Codified Ordinance No. 351.18 OFF-STREET PARKING LIMITED TO HARD SURFACES is hereby amended to read:

"a. All motor vehicles, campers, boats, trailers, semitrailer, truck, vehicle and construction equipment shall be parked in an area consisting of asphalt, concrete or other impervious surface approved by the Building Inspector."

SECTION 2: In all other respects, Codified Ordinance No. 351.18 shall remain the same.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in the interest of the public health, welfare and safety for the reason that the immediate enforcement of this measure is necessary for the health, welfare, safety and protection of the community. As such an emergency measure this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor. If not so passed as an emergency, it shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
