**Pittsgrove Township Development Regulations Ordinance  
Checklist - Schedule "L" – Soil Movement**

Any person proposing to remove from or to transport from off site and place or dispose of soils onto premises within the Township as regulated by § 60-53.1 of the Pittsgrove Township Development Regulations Ordinance shall, in addition to the information required in connection with a major subdivision or site plan review as applicable to the type of development involved, shall also provided the information as set forth below to the extent that same is not already shown or provided in other application documents submitted. Applicants are advised that such soil movement activity as governed by § 60-53.1 is a two-part process which requires: (1) Planning Board approval of the proposed activity in connection with a specific land development and (2) approval by the Township Committee of the soil movement in the Township in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80 of the Township Code.

**Instructions:** Fill in the name of the applicant or the development and date on each page of this checklist. In the column of brackets at the left, place the appropriate letter that corresponds to the status of the information requested. An application shall not be considered complete until all of the materials and information specified below have been submitted and is determined to be complete by the Land Use Board.

(b) The total number of cubic yards of soil to be excavated and removed from or transported to the premises.
