Signs Allowed Without a Permit (§ 380-102) [Amended 9-20-2010 by L.L. No. 3-2010]

District: Any	Maximum Size	Time Limits
Nameplate and/or address sign. One attached to a building	1 square foot	
Home occupation. One attached wall sign, nameplate or address sign denoting the name and occupation of the resident maintaining a professional office as a home occupation, authorized by special permit	2 square feet	
Sale, lease or rental of the premises. One nonilluminated ground or wall sign advertising the premises upon which the sign is located	R-1, R-2: 4 square feet All others: 8 square feet	10 days after sale, transfer or closing of transaction
Contractor, architect or engineer. One nonilluminated wall or ground sign denoting the architect, engineer or contractor, placed on the premises where construction, repair or renovation is in progress, but expressly excluding products, services or other forms of advertising	Each side: R-1, R-2: 12 square feet All others: 16 square feet	10 days after completion
Temporary, nonilluminated signs. Designed exclusively to inform the general public of a real estate open house, garage or estate sale, fundraising campaign, political campaign, social event, civic undertaking or annual festivity to be erected or placed on the property where such event will take place. Such signs shall be placed four feet from any property line or public sidewalk, shall not impede the vision of any street or otherwise create a hazard and may not be placed on public property except by written permission of the Board of Trustees. The Superintendent of Public Works or the Code Enforcement Officer of the Village shall remove any sign in violation of this provision	Each side: 16 square feet	30 days prior and 5 days after event
Location signs. Shall be permitted upon recommendation of the Planning Board and written approval of the Board of Trustees when located upon public property	2 square feet	
District: B-1, B-2, B-3, B-4 and LI-BP		
Window signs. Shall be allowed for each business. Window signs shall not exceed 50% of the window glass surface on which they appear, measured around the exterior edges of the sign or the lettering as a whole when directly applied to the window. Window signs above the first story are limited to lettering directly on the window, which shall be a maximum height of eight inches per line with a maximum of two lines, and such signs shall only be located on the primary street frontage of the building, except for corner lot buildings		
Temporary banners. Calling attention to a promotional sale or similar event. Banners shall be located on the face of the building	16 square feet combined maximum	21 days total in any thirty-day period, no more than 3 days after event

District: B-1, B-2, B-3, B-4 and LI-BP	Maximum Size	Time Limits
One nonilluminated A-frame/sandwich sign. Shall be allowed to be placed in front of a business at least four feet from the adjacent street pavement edge and so as not to obstruct a public sidewalk or the vision of drivers and pedestrians. Only one such sign shall be permitted per business, and, if placed on Village property, the business owners must have written permission of the Board of Trustees	Each side: 6 square feet 4 feet in height	During business hours as approved and established
