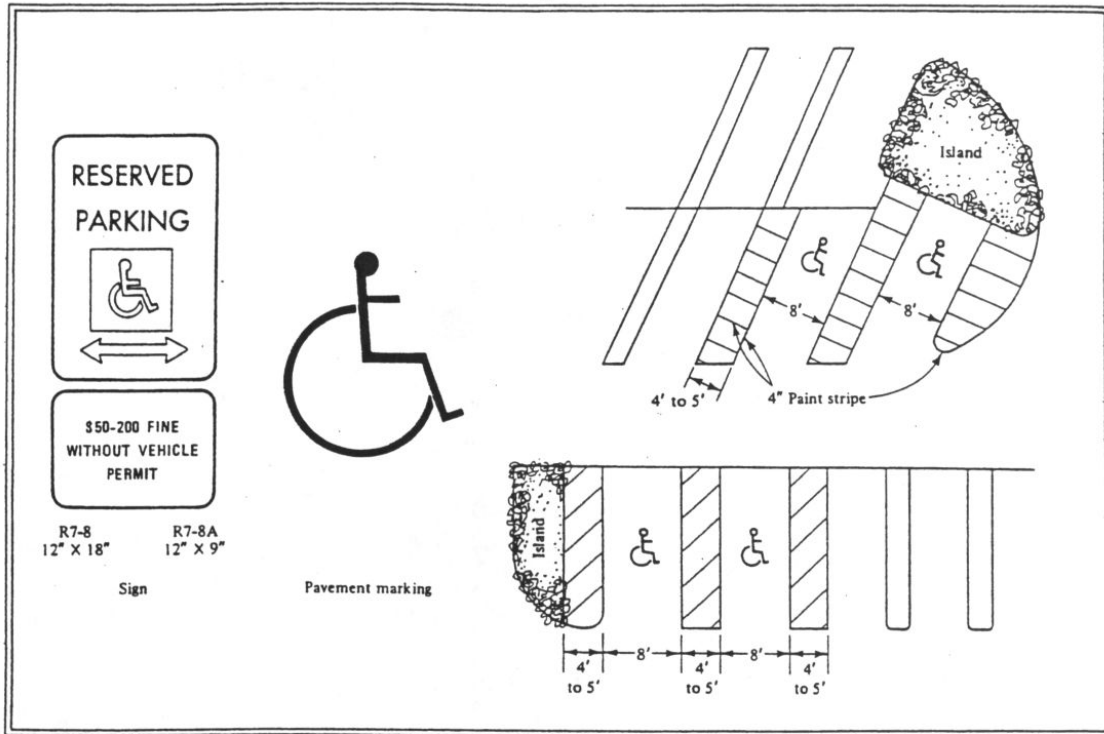

ACCESSIBLE PARKING SPACES

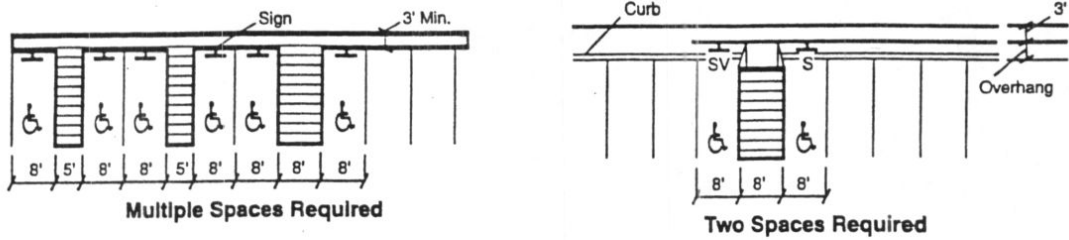
Total parking spaces provided	Required minimum number of accessible spaces
1 to 5	1 ^a
6 to 25	1
26 to 50	2
51 to 75	3
76 to 100	4
101 to 150	5
151 to 200	6
201 to 300	7
301 to 400	8
401 to 500	9
501 to 1,000	2% of total
more than 1,000	20 plus one for each 100 over 1,000

Note a. The accessible space shall be provided but is not required to be designated as reserved for physically disabled (see Section 1109.2).

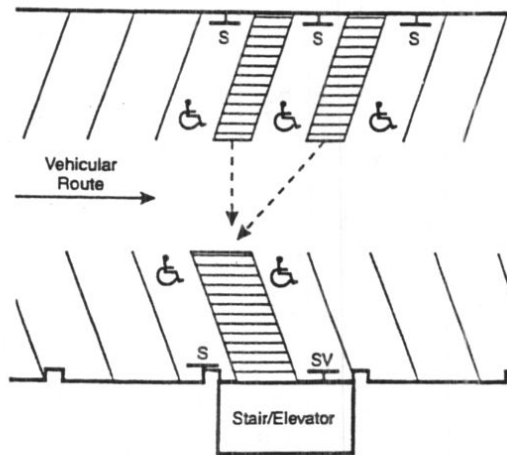
