A Local Law to Amend the Code of the Town/Village of East Rochester, Chapter 193 Article IV entitled "Temporary signs" by amending and restating in its entirety Section 193-18 D. (4) as follows:

193-18 D. Political signs shall be permitted, subject to the following standards:

(4) Such signs shall be erected not more than **forty-five (45)** ~~90~~ days prior to the election or event to which they relate and shall be removed within seven (7) days after the election or event to which they relate.

Repeal. All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Conflicts of Law. Whenever any local law, ordinance or regulation of the Town/Village of East Rochester, County of Monroe, State of New York or United States of America is inconsistent with this Local Law whichever local law, ordinance, or regulation is more stringent shall supersede the less stringent local law, ordinance, or regulation.

Separability. If any part or provision of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this Local Law or the application thereof to other person or circumstances, and the Village Board of the Town/Village of East Rochester hereby declares that it would have passed this Local Law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that there has been presented to the Village Board of the Town/Village of East Rochester, Monroe County, New York, on June 12, 2025, Local Law #2 of 2025 entitled "A Local Law to Amend Chapter 193-18 D. (4); of the Code of the Town/Village of East Rochester entitled "Temporary signs".

The proposed local law is intended to amend the above-described provisions of Chapter 193-18 D. (4) of the Town/Village code regarding the permitted time period for the installation and placement of Political signs. A copy of the proposed Local Law is on file with the Town/Village Clerk.
