#### APPENDIX B

**Barrington Historic Register Properties**  
**(as referenced in Article XXIV, Development Plan Review)**  
**[Amended 6-12-1995 by Ord. No. 95-4]**

The following properties in Barrington are listed or formally declared eligible for listing on the National and State Registers of Historic Places:

**Barrington Civic Center Historic District** -- East side of County Road including the Prince's Hill Cemetery (established in 1728), the Town Hall (1887-8), the former Leander Peck School (1916-7) and Woods Pond.

**Barrington and Warren Bridges** -- County Road over the Barrington and Warren Rivers, both built in 1914.

**Belton Court** -- Middle Highway (part of the Zion Bible Institute), built in stages between 1905 and 1928.

**Nayatt Light** -- Nayatt Point, includes the lightkeeper's dwelling (1828), and brick tower and cast-iron lantern (1856).

All properties subsequently listed on the National Register shall be covered by the applicable provisions of this chapter.
