ORDINANCE 15.36.260 BATTERIES**

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Kure Beach, in the State of North Carolina, as follows:

**SECTION 1:**        **ADOPTION** “15.36.260 Batteries Used For Storing Energy” of the Town of Kure Beach Municipal Code is hereby *added* as follows:

BEFORE ADOPTION

15.36.260 Batteries Used For Storing Energy (Non-existent)

AFTER ADOPTION

15.36.260 Batteries Used For Storing Energy(*Added*)

Batteries and accessories used for storing energy may be mounted on the sides and rear of the serviced structure provided that the batteries are not mounted any higher than the manufacturer’s installation directions for minimum distance from the ground and shall not project into the required setback.
