

## **APPENDIX A: TREES SUITABLE FOR URBAN STREET PLANTINGS**

### **Small Trees (under 30 feet)**

*Acer campestre* ‘Queen Elizabeth’—Queen Elizabeth hedge maple  
*Acer tataricum*—Tatarian maple  
*Crataegus crus-galli* ‘Inermis’—Thornless cockspur hawthorn  
*Prunus serrulata* ‘Amanogawa’—Japanese flowering cherry  
*Syringa reticulata* ‘Summer Snow’, ‘Regent’, ‘Ivory Silk’—Japanese tree lilac

### **Medium Trees (30 feet to 45 feet)**

*Acer campestre*—Hedge maple  
*Aesculus x carnea* ‘Briotii’—Ruby red chestnut (specify street tree form)  
*Carpinus betulus* ‘Fastigiata’—Upright european hornbeam  
*Carpinus caroliniana*—American hornbeam  
*Koelreuteria paniculata*—Golden rain tree  
*Phellodendron amurense* ‘Macho’—Amur cork tree (male trees only)  
*Prunus yedoensis*—Yoshino cherry  
*Quercus acutissima*—Sawtooth oak  
*Sorbus alnifolia*—Korean mountain ash  
*Sorbus aucuparia*—European mountain ash  
*Sorbus aucuparia* ‘Fastigiata’—Upright mountain ash

### **Large Trees (over 45 feet)**

*Acer rubrum*—Red maple (many cultivars; ‘Autumn Flame’ and ‘Red Sunset’ may have better branching structure than ‘October Glory’ or ‘Armstrong’)  
*Celtis laevigata* ‘All Seasons’—Sugar hackberry  
*Celtis occidentalis* ‘Prairie Pride,’ ‘Magnifica’—Hackberry  
*Corylus colurna*—Turkish filbert  
*Eucommia ulmoides*—Hardy rubber tree  
*Ginkgo biloba*—Ginkgo (male selections only)  
*Gleditsia triacanthos* ‘Inermis’—Thornless honeylocust  
*Gymnocladus dioica*—Kentucky coffee tree (male cultivars like ‘Macho’)  
*Liquidambar styraciflua*—Sweet gum (‘Rotundiloba’ is seedless)  
*Metasequoia glyptostroboides*—Dawn redwood  
*Nyssa sylvatica*—Black gum  
*Platanus x acerifolia*—London plane tree  
*Quercus alba*—White oak  
*Quercus bicolor*—Swamp white oak  
*Quercus imbricaria*—Shingle oak  
*Quercus phellos*—Willow oak  
*Quercus robur*—English oak  
*Quercus shumardii*—Shumard oak

*Sophora japonica* 'Halka,' 'Regent'—Japanese scholar tree  
*Taxodium distichum*—Bald cypress  
*Tilia americana* 'Wandell'—Legend American linden  
*Tilia americana* 'Redmond'—Redmond linden  
*Tilia cordata*—Little leaf linden cultivars  
*Tilia euchlora*—Crimean linden (ungrafted specimens)  
*Tilia tomentosa*—Silver linden  
*Zelkova serrata* 'Village Green' or 'Halka'—Japanese zelkova
